Sharyland 2013 Load Management Program

Participation Information



Sharyland Utilities' 2013 Load Management Standard Offer Program (SOP) is a performance-based program that offers incentive payments to participating customers for voluntarily curtailing electric load.

The program's goal is to enroll 2MW of curtailable load, with a program budget reservation limit of 25%¹ per customer. It is designed to reduce demand during peak periods, weekdays 1-7 p.m. CDT, **June through September**. Participants will have 60-minutes' notice to curtail with a maximum of 5 requests to curtail for up to 18 hours per year.





Customer Commitment

Participating customers agree to a one-year commitment. Though no penalties are incurred if customers opt out of the program at an earlier time, customers that opt out will not be paid the program incentive. The customer commits to a maximum of five curtailments each year as follows:

One (1) Scheduled Curtailment of one-to-two hours' duration, plus a maximum of four (4) Unscheduled Curtailments of up-to four (4) hours each.

Eligible Project Site Requirements

- Provide at least 100 kW peak demand reduction at project site.
- Be equipped with an Interval Data Recorder (Sharyland will provide).
- Be non-residential customers of Sharyland.

Customer does not qualify for this program if curtailment presents a safety or health risk or if curtailment would result in building vacancies or the re-location of existing operations to a location outside of the area served by Sharyland.



Financial Benefits

Sharyland will set aside **\$40 per kW** for the contracted curtailable load amount (kW) of each customer accepted to the program. Actual payment will be made on or before November 15, 2013. For example, a customer who contracts for 500 kW and fully meets that obligation would earn \$20,000 for that program year. Participating customers who deliver load reductions in excess of their committed curtailable load may receive an additional payment for some or all of the additional amount delivered if additional program budget is available, at Sharyland's discretion.

Program Review and Approval

The application process for the 2013 program year begins on a rolling basis **on April 1, 2013**. All applications must be **contracted by May 15, 2013**. All applications are reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis; however, Sharyland reserves the right to move an application up or down the priority list based on the quality of the proposed curtailable load, evaluation of the proposed customer's ability to implement curtailments or other such reasonable factors as may be applied. Applications will be accepted for the SOP until all funds have been committed.

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
